From Vademecum:

The COST Action <u>may be extended</u> beyond its originally intended end date if, during the course of the Action, the MC determines that it is, for technical reasons, impossible to bring the work under the Action to a satisfactory conclusion within the originally envisaged period of duration. Extensions of COST Actions are exceptional and must be duly justified from an S&T or network activities point of view. The final assessment of Actions having benefited from an extension shall include a dedicated section assessing the extension period (see COST 4114/13).
